Dear Readmit Applicant:

To be eligible for readmission consideration as a formerly dismissed University student, you must have fulfilled a mandatory period of two (2) consecutive semesters of nonenrollment (summer sessions collectively count as one semester). You also must have cleared any original admission core course deficiencies and/or other holds on your record, as you cannot be readmitted until all of these holds have been cleared.

The attached **Readmission Questionnaire** is an important element in the readmission process. The most important factor that will help support your case for readmission is successful academic performance since you were dismissed (e.g., independent study correspondence courses or credits earned at other post-secondary institutions; this is mandatory if dismissed with original admission core course deficiencies). **NOTE:** Please be prepared to send us an official, final transcript to document the completion of the work and the grade or grades earned.

Students who have been away from the University for an extended period of time (i.e. two [2] years or longer) may also include work experience and other appropriate experiences they believe have contributed toward their development and helped prepare them to achieve further academic success.

To apply for readmission, submit your completed Application for Readmission, the Readmission Questionnaire, and all supporting documentation to the Office of Admissions. All items must be postmarked no later than May 1 for the summer term and the fall semester and December 1 for the spring semester.
